By now eveyone should have received a copy of our 2021 schedule. It is also on our web-site, <u>osanglers.org</u> under fish'n news. This is where you may also see about how many spots are open on each charter. I will be trying to update the schedule at least once a month, hopefully twice a month. Remember if you see that a charter is full, the Charter Master will keep a list of alternates, so sign up as an alternate. If you want what many consider the "Good Bunks", this is done at the time of signing up. You can see the bunk layouts, again they're on our web-site under resources. So when you call the Charter Master to get on the charter, you request your bunk at that time.

Due to the weather we had to cancel our March charter. I'm pleased to report that our April, May and June charters are filled. Let's take a look at July. We need to please get our July charters filled. We have a Full day on July 15th, cost is \$228, scheduled for the Coronados.

There are 9 open spots: contact Jim at 760-450-7060. Then we have a 1/2 day charter on July 26th with 15 open spots. This 1/2 day will be fishing for Calicos. The cost is \$63: contact Deek Takacs at 949-456-1166. To finish off the month: on July 29 & 30, we have an overnight charter. This charter is scheduled for the Coronados. The cost is \$385 with 9 open spots: contact Bill Modi at 760-580-3254. Remember that all charters through the end of July are open to friends and family. Please ask your friends and family if they would like to come out with us.

Both of July's Full day & Ovenight charters require passports. Please note that if the tuna and/or yellowtail are within range of either of these charters, then we don't have to go to the Coronados. We can go after the tuna or yellowtail.

Last year many of our Anglers told me if we had FULL DAY charters, they would be going with us fishing so that they wouldn't have to sleep on the boat. Well as you can see on this year's schedule we have plenty of full day charters. Don't wait for the last minute to get on a charter. If they all get filled, we can always add more. I hope to see many more of you out with your club this year. If you have any questions, please feel free to call or e-mail me at any time. Now let's all go fishing and have a great time!




IN MEMORIAM
