HEAD CHARTER MASTER'S REPORT

Hello fellow Anglers,

Unfortunately, we had to cancel our June 2 five-day charter due to weather. We are now ready to change gears and start our tuna season.

We still have a few charters here coming up that need help in getting filled. Our first half-day charter will be on July 26. The cost is \$63 and there are three open spots. This half-day charter will target Calicos for the day. Please contact Charter Master Deek Takacs at (949) 456-1166. Then to finish off the month of July, we will have our overnighter on July 29 & 30. The cost is \$385 with meals and visa included – there is one spot left. Please contact Charter Master Bill Modi at (760) 580-3254. July's overnighter was originally scheduled for the Coronado Islands, which requires us to bring our passports. If the tuna and/or yellowtail are within striking distance of the charter, then we will go to them. If they are not close, the Captain said we could go to San Clemente Island and skip the Coronado Islands. Each Angler would then be refunded the visa fee. So please, I'm asking for your help in getting these charters filled. Please ask your friends, neighbors and family members. I know with your help we can get these charters filled.

We also need to work at filling our August charters. We have two, ¾-day charters; two full-day charters, and a two and a half-day charter. Please note that the August 16 charter is designated "Youth," meaning with that charter, we may bring our nephews, nieces, and grandchildren, especially those under the age of 18. So please, let's get our charters filled and get out and enjoy the sport of FISHING!
