Hello fellow Anglers,

We still have a few more charters before our "Tuna" season starts. We have the May 10th-12"; it's a 1.5 day charter scheduled for the Cortes Bank Area. The charter is full, however we can always use an alternate. The cost is \$300, meals are all included. If you or someone you know wants to be an alternate, please contact Charter Master Daryl Evans at 951-551-7885.

June 2.5 day is full; however, again we can always use an alternate or two, you never know. This includes any and all filled charters.

For July we really need some Anglers. The July 15th full day has 2 open spots. Cost is \$228 visa is included. Contact Charter Master Jim at 760-450-7060. Then our first 1/2 day charter is July 26th. The cost is \$63 and there are 13 open spots. This 1/2 day charter will target Calicos for the day. Please contact Charter Master Deek Takacs at 949-456-1166. Then to finish off the month of July: there is our overniter July 29th & 30th. The cost for this is \$385 with meals & visa included. Please contact Charter Master Bill Modi at 760-580-3254. Both July's full day & overniter are scheduled for the Coronado Islands; this is why Passports are required. Now if the Tuna and or Yellowtail are within striking distance for both or either charter, then we will go to them and skip the Coronado Islands. Update:

Once again, we have been successful in keeping our Live Bait fishery (sardines and anchovies) from being cut off for another year at the Pacific Fisheries Management Council. They recognize that their lack of having an accurate stock assessment and the inaccuracies of their models are hindering their decision making process to negatively impact our fishing industry.

CCA CAL and the Marina Del Rey Anglers released 3700 white seabass recently outside the harbor. This is the first of many growout pens that will be releasing fish in the next month.

AB817, the 12-month fishing license made it out of the first committee and on to Appropriations.

SB470 – the combo hunting and fishing license bill, has had to make some amendments which include to remove the discount and postpone implementation until 2024.

We continue to fight to keep our access during all the meetings regarding 30 x 30 at the Federal and State levels. We keep pushing for recognition of the positive role that fishing and hunting play in conservation. We are working to get protective area definitions that allow for well-managed and sustainable wildlife-dependent activities.
