We have completed our first charter for the 2021 year. This was a full day charter that went with 16 Anglers aboard the Relentless down to the Coronado Islands. I would like to extend a thank you to Charter Master Kelly Kissinger for a job well done. The weather was pretty good for us; in the morning it was great, sunshine and somewhat flat seas. By noon the wind started kicking up and so did the seas, still it was manageable to fish. Our catch consisted of 63 Vermilions (Reds), 28 Boccaccio (Salmon Grouper) and 37 various other Rock Fish giving us a total of 128 Rock Fish. There was one Lingcod caught and was released. Our jackpot was won with a 6 pound Vermillion by a guest, Bob Kahle, who donated \$25 of his winnings to the Anglers 4 Military program, thank you Bob.
