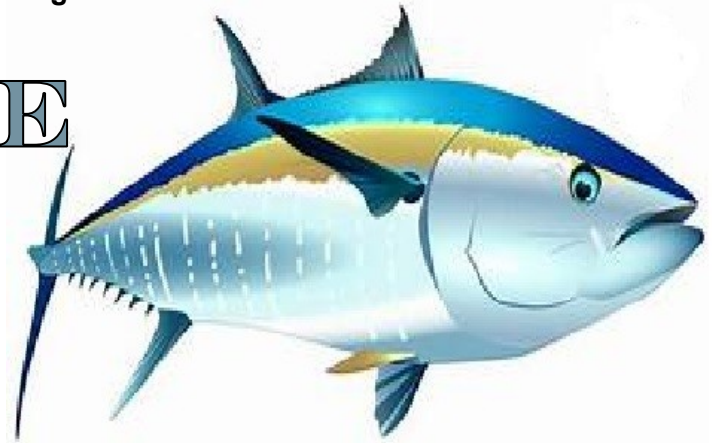

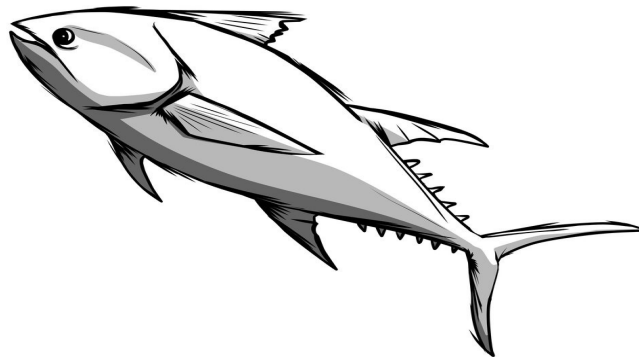
PRESIDENTS MONTHLY MESSAGE

We are working at the Pacific Fisheries Management Council to keep shallow set long lines from the Hawaii fleet from fishing outside and inside our EEZ.

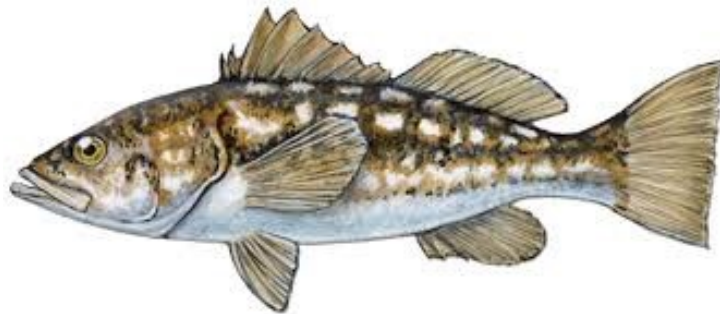
Dungeness crab was closed 2 months early due to whale entanglements from commercial gear. CDFW is including recreational lobster nets under future restrictions even though we have had no interactions with our gear.

Tijuana sewage spill continues to be a huge environmental disaster along our coast line.

I have been very vocal at all levels of government to get some solutions to this important issue.

The California Fish & Game Commission is developing a new strategic plan to coincide with its sesquicentennial (150th) anniversary in April. To aid with the planning process, the Commission is seeking your input through a short survey to guide strategic goals and objectives that incorporate stakeholder priorities.

We had a very successful year with our program. We had four Anglers 4 Military charters go out this past year. One charter was for the 12th year co-sponsored by the Escondido Rotary Club, another charter was fully funded by Daniel & Angel Smedley. There other charters were funded by the hard work & generosity of our members, I thank everyone for you contributions and support. We also learned that the gear that we have for our Military Charters is insufficient. I would like to extend a very big 'Thank You' to Joey Helgren of Helgren's Landing for all of his support for our program. From the great boat cost to lending us some gear so that our Military could successfully catch some good bottom fish, we strive to get our participants to catch fish so that they may take their catch home to their families or share with their friends and enjoy their catch knowing that they caught the meal. We stayed with in the budget for the four charters that run at about \$2400 per trip. We provide a breakfast burrito, also a lunch, snacks & fresh fruit with water & sodas. We also have jackpot winners 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners, plus we pay to fillet all the fish and tip the crew. The \$2400 may seem high to some, however if you could hear the participants and see their faces you would understand that this is a very low cost to give to the Men & Women that give so much to us. So I am asking for your continued donations & support for this program. I am starting a "Go Fund Me Account" in hopes of raising money for 30 new Rods & Reels for the Anglers 4 Military program.

It's also that time of year that I do our yearly canned food drive for our needy families aboard Camp Pendleton. So please bring you canned or boxed food items to our November 5th Club meeting, I am only doing the collection for the month of November. 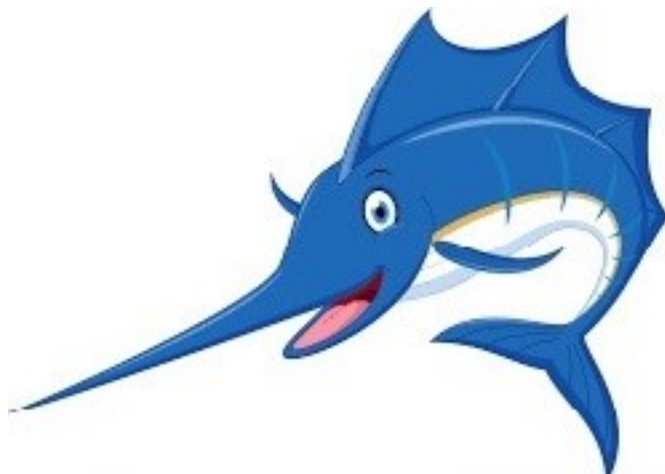

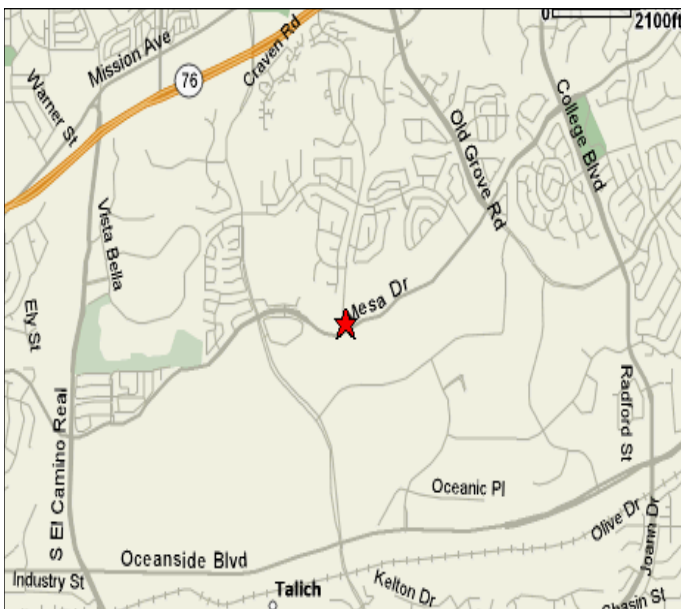

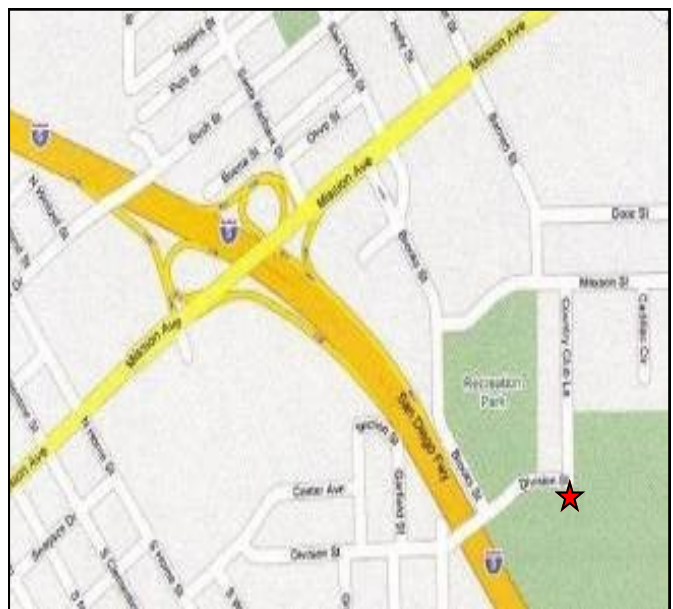
