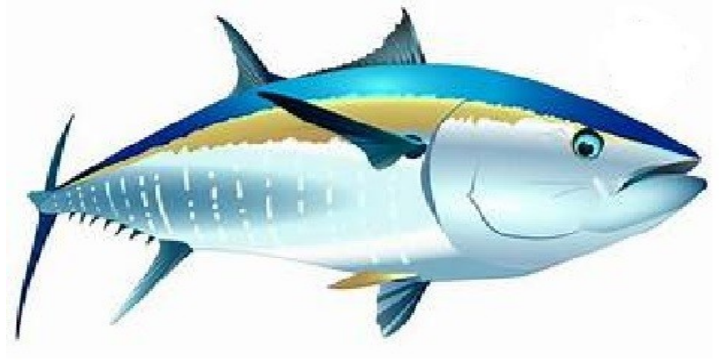

Well, holding up to the last eight or so years' tradition, the charter schedule was ready for our January meeting and was presented then as in the past. I have received many good complements on the schedule and I truly do thank you for that. Now all I need is for you, the club members, to get out fishing and help fill the charters. All charters through the end of June are open to friends and family members. In March the August-through-October charters will open at that meeting. Please remember that the Charter Masters may sign up only to 1/3 of the load prior to the opening of the charters.

We did get our January charter off the dock. We did a 1.5 day with 11 Anglers aboard the Relentless. We went down South to the Colonel area and Captain Mikey did find some Yellow Tail, However they weren't interested. He did however find some great fishing of Ling Cod, and we bagged 45 Lings. A Fish & Game Commission recently met in Sacramento. Trout simplification regulation package is still progressing forward. Purple urchins continue to be overpopulated and the kelp forests haven't rebounded yet. There was a planting of white abalone recently. Dungeness crab recreational anglers are being pushed for further restrictions due to recent whale entanglements by the commercial fleet. We are negotiating these restrictions as they may set precedent towards our lobster fishery later.

This text is a repetition of that shared in the January Newsletter.

Gerry Graf has two trips scheduled to Alaska this summer. Each has two openings. The June trip is to Sitka for five days of fishing during **king** salmon season. That trip will be from June 20th to 26th. We fly up on Saturday, June 20th, fish for five days, and return on Friday June 26th. We stay at Sitka Point Lodge. The trip is full service. All meals, fishing, fish processing, etc. are included. Total cost including the lodge, airfare, tips, etc. runs around \$5000. The August trip is during **silver** salmon season and is to Ketchikan. That trip is planned from August 9th to 15th, also with five days of fishing with our good friend Tony Knuteson at Aurora Sport Fishing. This trip is somewhat less expensive as we rent an apartment and prepare most of our own meals. 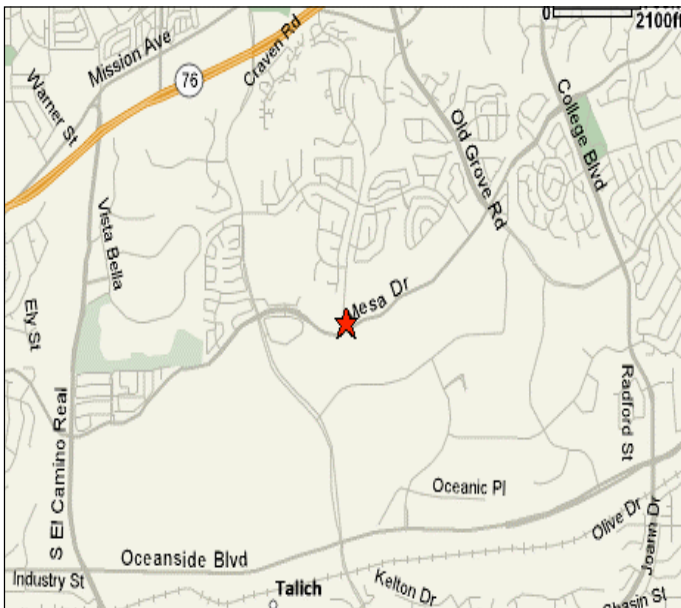

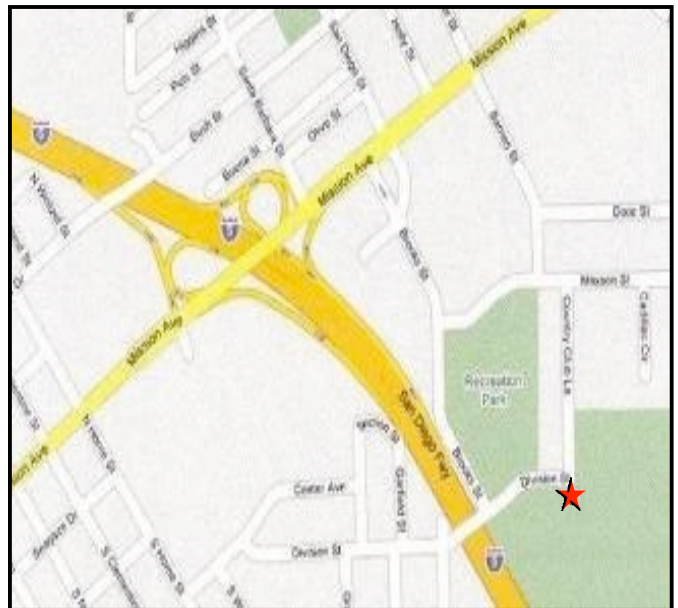
