Finally! We had our first charter go out this year on June 7, 8 & 9, 1.5 day charter. They went out to the 60 mile bank for bottom fishing. Everyone on the charter went home with limits of bottom fish, which are all quality fish. The jackpot was taken by Dan Carter with a 10lb Bocaccio. Thank you to Charter Master Daryl Evans. We had a second charter go out on a 1/2 day trip June 14. The jackpot was a Sheepshead caught by a non-member. Although the fishing was very slow, all the Anglers had a good time. Thank you Charter Master Sandra O'Brien. Reports and photos will be on our web-site. Due to weather we had to cancel our June 20, 21 & 22, a 1.5 day charter. Thank you Mother Nature.

Our next charter is July 9, 10 & 11, 1.5 day. This is our club's first offshore charter. We will be targeting the pelagic fish. This charter is full, however, you can sign up as an alternate. You will need to reach Charter Master Bill Modi.

Just a reminder: Each charter is to be paid for with a separate check. "One check – one charter". Please write the date of the charter in the memo area of your check. Your payment must be given directly to the Charter Master. DO NOT send it directly to the Treasurer.
