## **HEAD CHARTER MASTER'S REPORT**

Hello fellow Anglers,

Well, we finally got a great charter to go out this year. We departed on Monday, October 16th for a 2.5 day charter. We left with 13 members and 3 guest, we did return with a new Associate member. We boarded the Relentless around 6:30PM left the dock around 9:30PM. Got bait and tied up there till around 3:30AM. Then we were on our way, shortly after 6:30AM we set out our trolling rods. I believe it was around the 3rd team that hooked up with the first bite. It was a Yellow Fin Tuna. We started to bait fish and picked at the Yellow Fin Tuna and just drifted. Before you knew it was lunch time. Then the Skip Jack showed up so the Captain Mikey made a very small move, luckily the Skip Jacks didn't follow. So we then continued to drift and pick at the Yellow Fin. By the end of day one we had landed 89 Yellow Fin Tuna, 1 Dorado and 5 Skip Jack. Everyone was exhausted and happy. That night the Captain made a move a little further West. In the morning we started the troll. It wasn't until just about lunch time or just past lunch when we finally found some Dorado. We successfully landed 78 Dorados and 9 Yellow Fin. At around 7PM we called it a day. Our two day total was, 98 Yellow Fin, 79 Dorado and 5 Skip Jack. Day one Jackpot went to a guest with a 42 pound Yellow Fin, day two jack pot went to Louis Drucker with a 34 pound Yellow Fin. Not one of the 98 Yellow Fin were under 30 pounds. Daryl Evans had landed the most fish for the two days. I understand that Dan Carter had 2nd place on day two, Dan tells me he would have had 1st place except that they bled his fish. What a great trip. Thank you to Captain Mikey and the Relentless Crew for a job well done again.

We have a 1.5 day charter set to depart on November 9th and return on the 11th. We are going to try and head out to San Clemente Island. Hopefully find some tuna if not you know that there some great bottom fishing there. The cost is \$489, we can go with 14 Anglers. Right now we have 6. So call me at 760-450-7060 if you want on this charter. It's open to family and friends as well. I know it's the same day as the picnic. We will gather around 5PM at H&M.

I am looking for Charter Masters for this upcoming season. I will have the Charter Master training on Tuesday, November 21st. We will start at 8:30AM. Location will be announced very soon. If you plan on attending, please let me know so that I have enough material for everyone. My plan is to have the 2024 Charter Schedule ready for our December club meeting. Let's see if it can be done.


