Hello fellow Anglers,

Well we finally got our first Charter off the docks this past month. We had our extended 1.5 day Charter depart from Sea Center aboard the Blue Horizon, we went out to the San Clemente Island. On Thursday morning we started fishing and we got our limits of rockfish also tried for Yellowtail in the morning and all day. The only person that nailed one was Steve Stump which turned out to break the past record set back in 2016. The new class one record for the Yellowtail is 38lb and was the jackpot for the day congratulations Steve. Day two we were at a different part of the island and we scored on limits of whitefish then we headed home. No jackpot for second day because all the fish are basically about the same size. Then on Saturday the 8th we went out for our second charter for this year. It was scheduled to be for very deep bottom fishing, 800 plus feet which we did. On this trip, the boat was skippered by Second Captain Matt that did a fantastic job and got us on the fish right away once we got out there. We all came home with limits of Rock fish, nice size Mexican reds. We also got a new club one record with a black Gill Rockfish at 5lb. this as well was a jackpot fish, congratulations to returning member Mike Arrington. 

# **ELECTION PROCEDURES**

Elections will be held at the September meeting for Head Charter Master and then at the November meeting for President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

At the July meeting it will be announced that the Nominating Committee is accepting nominations for all the above offices.

Also in order to be able to be included with mail in ballots, person running must be nominated by August 10<sup>th</sup> for HCM or October 10<sup>th</sup> for Pres, VP, Sec. and Treas.

An e-mail will be sent out to all members with a list of candidates.

To mail in a ballot, you must include the voting OSA member's name, then stating who you're voting for. No write in candidates are accepted.

The envelope must be mailed to a designated member(s) of the Nominating Committee. The OSA Members name and address must be on the envelope as the return address.

All mail in ballots must be received prior to the general meeting of the election.

Envelopes will not be opened nor counted until such time as the voting takes place.

No floor nominations day of elections.

Once a mail in ballot has be received no other ballot may be turned in or changed.

Once you have mailed in a ballot, you may not vote in person.

In person voting at the general meetings are still in effect as well.
