HEAD CHARTER MASTER'S REPORT

Hello fellow Anglers,

I hope that you and your families are having a safe Memorial week-end. Please remember to take a moment on Monday morning to think about all the men & women that gave the ultimate sacrifice for the freedoms that we have.

Not sure if you're aware. All you service connected Veterans, should check with your county recorders offices and see if you are entitled to any discounts on your property taxes. I saw that it looks like San Diego county does give a discount. Who knew?

Well, we did it again. Our May charter was canceled because we the club couldn't get the 9th Angler. So still no fish reports.

We have a June Charter that is scheduled to depart on Wednesday June 5th and return on Friday the 7th the return is not at 6:00 a.m. it will return about 2:00 in the afternoon. This is an extended 1.5 day charter. So we can have 2 days limits, we are scheduled to go out to San Clemente Island area, weather permitting. This charter will go and we are short one Angler. If you like to help the club get this filled the cost is \$550 meals included please contact Charter Master Jim Mauritz at 760-450-7060. You may be asking. How can this charter go out short? Will, I trusted a member when he signed up? I tried contacting him many times for the payment, finally when I was able to get hold of him, he told me he couldn't make it. We will be departing around 5:00 a.m. and returning around 4:00 or 5:00 p.m. This is a deep water Rock Cod trip, the cost is \$242, this includes the meals for the day and water and soda are included with your cost.
