HEAD CHARTER MASTER'S REPORT

Hello fellow Anglers,

Well we had another trip go out this past month. I like to thank Charter Master Bill Modi for job well done. This charter did head down south into Mexico. Basically we patty hopped around looking for the right patty. We found a few and worked hard and getting the fish we did. Congratulations to the jackpot winner Roy Sheetz for about a seven pound Dorado. For the full report of this charter please see our website using the tab "fish'n news".

I've talked with Captain Mikey about the overnight for August 19th-20th. I have another week or so to try to get this filled. Things are looking up so please consider jumping on this charter right away. The cost is \$310 departs on the 19th returns on the 20th. Again this is looking for tuna, Yellowtail and Dorados. Please contact Charter Master Doug Jenkins at 650-291-8474. This is the only over-night or full day charter with open spots. We need 9 more Anglers.

The full day charter that was set for October 8th has been canceled. The new owner of the Voyager is sticking to the contracts without working with us and so the 90 days were up and I had no choice but to cancel that charter.

We still have plenty of room on the 3/4 day charters for this year. The August 26th has 2 open spots and the September 16th has 8 open spots please contact Richard Reed at 530-313-8884. These 3/4 day charters are 100% in shore fishing. The our September 2.5 day and October 2.5 day charters each has pne open spot left on them.

I'd like to clear something up that I've received some inquiries about. On our 3/4 day charters we have a \$200 galley minimum. The words gotten around that they have never seen this done before. Well this is a standard practice with many private charters, this is to ensure that the galley earns some money. So this is common and normal. So what we're going to do is when you're checking in the Charter Master will collect \$10 and this will go towards your galley. This will ensure that the club is not stuck paying any fees if we do not hit the \$200. The \$200 should be met with no problem. So with a \$10 credit, this means you can go into the galley and have breakfast, burger, beer, water, soda & snacks, and you have \$10 already paid in towards that. ELECTION PROCEDURES

Elections will be held at the September meeting for Head Charter Master and then at the November meeting for President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

At the July meeting it will be announced that the Nominating Committee is accepting nominations for all the above offices.

Also in order to be able to be included with mail in ballots, person running must be nominated by August 10th for HCM or October 10th for Pres, VP, Sec. and Treas.

An e-mail will be sent out to all members with a list of candidates.

To mail in a ballot, you must include the voting OSA member's name, then stating who you're voting for. No write in candidates are accepted.

The envelope must be mailed to a designated member(s) of the Nominating Committee. The OSA Members name and address must be on the envelope as the return address.

All mail in ballots must be received prior to the general meeting of the election.

Envelopes will not be opened nor counted until such time as the voting takes place.

No floor nominations day of elections.

Once a mail in ballot has be received no other ballot may be turned in or changed.

Once you have mailed in a ballot, you may not vote in person.

In person voting at the general meetings are still in effect as well.
